COMMERCIAL REBATES *from Austin Energy*

Changes in manufacturing standards for air conditioning and lighting require the phase-out of some building equipment commonly in use.

Now is a good time to take advantage of special incentives to upgrade your equipment and save on your energy bills.

LIGHTING

The Energy Policy Act of 2005 calls for the phase-out of T-12 lighting by July 2012.

When 32-watt T-8s become standard, Austin Energy will no longer offer rebates for installing them.

Retrofit T-12 lighting to a 32-watt T8 or better.

- Receive standard rebates PLUS a 20% bonus.
- Save up to 45% on your lighting bill.
- Tax deductions of up to \$1.80 per square foot apply.

AIR CONDITIONING

The 1990 Clean Air Act mandated that refrigerant R-22 (most commonly known by the brand name Freon) – the longtime industry standard refrigerant used in most air conditioning and heat pump systems – must be phased out. New air conditioning equipment that uses R-22 can no longer be manufactured and shipped “pre-charged”.

Upgrade air conditioning currently using R-22 refrigerant.

- Receive standard commercial rebates PLUS a 20% bonus.
- Save up to \$600 on your cooling bill.
- Tax deductions of up to \$1.80 per square foot apply.
(Please consult your tax professional for tax advice.)

To qualify for the bonus rebates, apply by August 31, 2012.

Projects must be completed and inspected by September 30, 2012.
